

MINUTES OF PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

April 11, 2011

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a regular Planning Commission meeting was held at City Hall on the 11th day of April, 2011 at 6:30 PM

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS PLANNING COMMISSION MEETINGS: Dean made a motion to approve the minutes, Sannes seconded. All Ayes.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN RECOMMENDATION: Chris Gastner presented the full Draft of the Comprehensive Plan along with the updated Land Use Plan, the Transportation Map and the Official Zoning Map. **MOTION:** Motion made by Egler to accept the resolution recommending adoption of the Comprehensive Plan, second by Borgstrom. All Ayes.

DODGE COUNTY REZONING PROPOSAL: The Fair Board is petitioning the County to change the Fair Ground Property to Commercial to be able to advertise on the buildings facing Mantorville Ave. The Fair ground property is currently zoned Urban Expansion. This is in clear conflict of our newly adopted Comprehensive Plan to rezone this Commercial. The City of Kasson has no jurisdiction in this matter but we have been asked to comment. After discussion the Planning Commissioners are in agreement and would like Martin to comment that this is urban expansion area and we prefer it remain that way.

MAY MEETING: Staff is asking to reschedule the May Planning Commission meeting since they will be out of the office during the regularly scheduled Planning Commission meeting. The Commissioners agreed to reschedule the regular meeting to May 16 at 6:30 pm.
