CLEAN UP WEEK...begins on May 2nd until pickup has been completed. Items must be on the curb by 7:00 AM. There will be only one pass per home and a maximum of one load per household. Yard brush, leaves and grass clippings only. No dog or cat waste. No junk. No tires. Brush must be a maximum of 10 feet in length and must be piled parallel to the curb. No complete trees. Yard clippings must be in a plastic bag; limit of 15 bags per household and no heavier than one person can carry. Tires can be taken to Dodge County Landfill. Call 634-7875 for times and rates.
